- Sub Committee of the CEP Committee of Management will consider the nominations received and recommend any Life Memberships to the February Committee of Management meeting to be recognised at the AGM held in March.
- Committee of Management elects Life Members at the February meeting of the Committee of Management.
- Life Memberships are presented to the elected members at the AGM, unless otherwise determined by the Committee of Management.
