This session will consider what we know about the differences between novices and experts in teaching and leadership and what we can do, at school level, to ensure that everyone can be learners and that everyone is able to improve their practice. Schools are being asked to be collaborative, to take part in networks and to lead beyond their school. How can we make these collaborations effective and what kind of leadership do they need?
